

DIVORCE DOCUMENTATION CHECKLIST

Documents to provide your attorney

In preparing for a divorce, try to get as much of the following documentation as possible.

It may also be helpful to run a credit report on yourself.

€ Income Tax Returns (3 years)

€ Employment Records/Paystubs (3 years)

€ Financial Records

- Checking accounts
- Savings Accounts
- Money Market Accounts

€ Investment Account Statements

€ Pension Plan Information

€ Retirement Savings Accounts

€ Children's Bank Accounts

€ Debt Records

- Credit Card Statements
- Store charge cards
- Signature Loan

€ Wills and Trust Agreements

€ Social Security Statements

- € Mortgage information – If your name is on the mortgage, get a copy of the application because much of your spouse's information will be there.
- € Information about Other Real Estate
- € Vehicle Information – VIN numbers, loan or lease statements
- € Personal Property (including jewelry, artwork, collections, and antiques)
- € Copies of Utility bills
- € Child care expenses
- € Health insurance information
- € Other monthly expenditures
